

Exhibit Guidelines

For Septemberfest Celebration
Riverview Beach Park

1. All work must be original and created by the submitting artist. No kit work is permitted.
 - Copies of another artist's work should never be submitted for exhibit without acknowledging the source on the Exhibit card.
 - Artist's prints are acceptable if
 - ☐ they are from an original created by the submitting artist.
 - ☐ the method process is identified as: Archival/Giclees (guaranteed not to discolor for 80 years, are printed on archival paper, and are submitted with an authenticity certificate).
 - ☐ Photo prints are approved for photographers.
2. Presentation of the work:
 - Unless otherwise specified, all paintings, drawings and photography must be framed and matted according to the media needs.
 - The picture must be secured in the frame, and sturdy picture wire must be attached with screw eyes or D-Rings (approximately 1/3 distance from the top) to run across the back of the frame without too much slack. When hung, the wire should not extend above the frame.
 - Note: Paintings/photographs not appropriately wired for hanging will NOT be accepted. Tooth hangars attached to the top of the frame are not acceptable. This requirement enables us to safely hang artwork and photographs from hooks on the display panels.
 - Matting should be presented in a professional manner. This includes all paintings and photography. Mats should be clean and cut with sharp edges.
 - Each piece should be identified by a tag provided by SCAL upon check-in with a receipt provided for your records.
 - The Salem County Art League provides no insurance coverage for the artwork. If this is of concern, please check with your insurance agent.
 - Exhibitors may place name cards and other flyers and literature on the table to be picked up by visitors.
 - No work can be sold by the Salem County Art League. Private sales can be arranged between the artist/photographer and the buyer.
