Guidelines for Participation

- 1. Artist must be a resident of Salem County and 60 years old or older.
- 2. Work may be entered as a Professional or an Non-Professional
- 3. Work may be entered in any of 11 categories:
 - 1) Acrylics
 - 2) Mixed Media
 - 3) Pastels
 - 4) Sculpture
 - 5) Craft
 - 6) Oils
 - 7) Photography
 - 8) Watercolor
 - 9) Digital
 - 10) Works on Paper
 - 11) Prints
- 4. Work must have been completed within the last 3 years.
- 5. Artists may enter work in no more than <u>three</u> different categories. In the event that multiple entries entered by one artist places "First" in various categories, only one of the winning entries can be chosen to continue to the State competition. <u>Only one piece per artist can be submitted to the state competition</u>.
- 6. There are size limitations for all entries as well as framing guidelines
 - a) No larger than 30 inches x 30 inches
 - b) No smaller than 10 inches x 10 inches
 - c) Work must be framed and "wired" for hanging. No saw toothed hangers are allowed.
- 6. After the Salem County Exhibit and Competition, <u>all work</u> from the competition will be exhibited in the Gallery Hallway in the Fenwick Commons Building at Friends Village from June 24 until August 13. Work should be picked up on August 13 between 10 and Noon.

7. All work that is awarded a "First Place" ribbon will move on to the State Exhibit and Competitive Event and must be available to hang there until October 16. The SCAL show coordinators will deliver the work to the State exhibit venue. Artists may pick up their work at the State reception. However, the SCAL show coordinators will return the work to the Salem County artists if the artists are unable to attend the State reception.
