## Rules, Regulations, and Registration

- Art work must be no older than 3 years
- Categories include: Acrylics, Craft (original creations only), Digital Imagery, Works on Paper, Mixed Media, Oil, Pastel, Photography, Print, Sculpture, and Watercolor. Entries winning first place automatically advance to the State Competition. There are separate contests for Professional and Non-Professional Artists.
- Work must be no greater than 30 inches or less than 10 inches in any dimension including the outer edge frame.

### \*\*\*\* Artist Classification Defined\*\*\*\*

**Professional:** A person who meets 2 or more of the following qualifications:

- has sold artwork through commercial channels (including galleries, online galleries, craft shows, art shows, etc.)
- has been exhibiting their work for 2 or more years in professional galleries and/or professional art exhibits\*\*
- has had work selected in 2 or more juried art or craft shows\*\*
- has received 2 or more awards for their artwork \*\*
- holds (or has held professional membership in a guild or association)

**\*\* Exceptions:** Any artist who only enters their County Senior Art Show

**Non Professional:** A person who does not meet 2 or more of the above criteria, and who never exhibits his or her art work in any other show or venue except the Senior Citizen Art Contest and Exhibition does not have to identify him or herself as a “professional.”

**Categories - Circle your Medium**

- **Acrylics**
- **Craft** - One-of-a-kind original creations only. NO craft kits or molds.
- **Digital/Computer Art** - Artwork generated or altered using computer graphics software.
- **Works on Paper** - Includes hand-drawn work in mediums including charcoal, colored pencil, graphite, or pen+ink.
- **Mixed Media** - Art that combines 2 or more media, **neither of which clearly predominates.** This category includes collage and assemblage.
- **Oil Painting**
- **Pastel** - Includes chalk and oil pastel.
- **Prints** - Includes drawings and all print forms including etching, linoleum block, lithograph, woodcut, monoprint, silkscreen, etc.
- **Photography** - Includes color, black & white, or tinted photographs taken with a film-base or digital camera.
- **Sculpture** - Any work designed in 3-dimensions, carved or constructed in any medium, abstract, figurative, painted, or unpainted.
- **Watercolor** - Includes gouache.

## Artwork/Display Rules:

**NOTE:** Entries that place First must be available to go to the New Jersey Senior Citizen Art Show, and must be available until October 26, 2018.

- Hanging artwork, photos, or crafts must be no more than 30” and no less than 10” in any dimension including matting and framing.
- Sculpture or 3-D crafts may not exceed 20” in any dimension (measurements must include any base for the sculpture). Work should not exceed 40 pounds in weight.
- All artwork must be the original creation of the artist. No reproductions (such as giclee or other types of digital copies) of original art work will be accepted.
- No work made using kits or copies of another person’s artwork will be accepted.
- All works are to be delivered “show ready.” Any 2-D work must be matted, framed, and wired (with D-rings or screw eyes) ready for hanging. Paintings on canvas must be wired for hanging and the edges should be painted or finished, but they do not need to be framed. The 2-D artwork should be protected where necessary with plexiglas, mylar, glass, or other clear protective material. All work must be properly labeled at the back (or at the bottom, if 3-D). Labels will be available at the Registration Desk.
- Use of plexiglas instead of glass is strongly recommended for 2-D work to avoid damage to artwork. Plexiglas (not glass) is required for any 2-D pieces over 24” in any dimension.
- Any entry with a dollar value exceeding \$400 must have private insurance.
