Submit the following in an envelope (approximate size of 9" x 12") to the Salem County Art League by Friday, May 28. Mail to: Salem County Art League, PO Box 432, Woodstown, NJ 08098. OR This form, essay, letter of reference and 3 samples of work may be emailed to amdevitt@comcast.net.

-A **typed essay** (up to 300 words) on your personal goals and the role fine art will play in your future.

-A **letter of reference** from a member of the art community who is familiar with the quality of your work, e.g. a past/current art teacher or mentor.

-A non-returnable **samples of your work**. It may be in the form of a photo or photocopy reproduction, but must be in paper form, 8 1/2" x 11" one print per page for **three different works of art**. On the back of each page indicate the title, medium type (watercolor, oil, pencil, etc.), and a short description of each work. (*Tip: Be sure to use clear images of your work and make the image as large as possible on the paper.*) Completely computer generated artwork is not acceptable.
