Submit the following in an envelope (approximate size of 9" x 12") to the Salem County Art League by **Wednesday, July 15**. Mail to: Salem County Art League, PO Box 432, Woodstown, NJ 08098, OR the application form, essay, letter of reference, and 3 samples of work may be emailed to amdevitt@comcast.net.

-A typed essay (up to 300 words) on your personal goals and the role fine art will play in your future. -A letter of reference from a member of the art community who is familiar with the quality of your work, e.g. a past/current art teacher or mentor.

-Non-returnable samples of your work, which may be in the form of a photo or photocopy reproduction, but must be

- in paper form,
- 8 1/2" x 11" one print per page,
- for three different works of art.

-On the back of each page, indicate 1) the title, 2) medium type (watercolor, oil, pencil, etc.), and 3) a short description of each work.

(Tip: Be sure to use clear images of your work and make the image as large as possible on the paper.)

NOTE; Completely computer generated artwork is not acceptable.
