

Presenting Ken and Stephanie Goldman Artists Workshop

When: September 19-21, 10:00 am - 4:00 pm Where: Ware Agriculture Building, 51 Cheney Rd., Woodstown, NJ 08098 Instructor: Ken Goldman and Stephanie Goldman, San Diego, CA

This is a unique opportunity to study with two accomplished and warmhearted artist-educators at the same time. Ken and Stephanie are both well known for their ability to help each person find their own individual drawing and painting abilities. Below is their plan for the workshop.

"Let's have everyone bring in any idea, photos or work in progress they'd like advice on (in any medium). We both teach in a very hands-on way, using short individually tailored demonstrations to get an idea across. We would rather demonstrate with the student's own materials which they are already familiar with (if they bring in an extra paper or canvas for us to work on, they can keep the demo).

Day One

Day one is about basic drawing skills and how to turn a generalized idea into an actual composition. For instance, one can first work out ideas by drawing on inexpensive thinnish papers such as newsprint or tracing paper (materials that don't feel too precious) and then transfer whatever one comes up with onto a better piece of paper or canvas to make a final piece. (We'll demonstrate a couple of really simple ways to transfer rough drawings onto a good surface).

Day Two and Three

Days Two and Three will still be about everyone using any medium or technique they find intriguing, interesting or challenging. Whatever that is, Stephanie and I will then help them get started by either talking them through the process or doing an actual demonstration. We have had good success using this approach, even with a very full class, because together, we can cover much more territory. **Sky's the limit.**"
